A Message from the Vice President Robin Heyser

I have received many questions about Project 22 and how the EBACC Board of Directors began this amazing endeavor. Briefly, I want to take this opportunity to start from the beginning and share the timeline of this venture and why.

30 Years ago, partnering with East Berlin, Abbottstown, Reading and Hamilton Townships in Adams County and Paradise and Washington Townships in York County, the East Berlin Community Center was created and has been a very successful and fiscally responsible hub for our community. In 2021, after years of effort and research to ensure EBACC's success for decades to come, the conclusion was that the current location would not fit our future needs to expand and create new ways to serve, not only for recreational, enlightenment and educational purposes, but also to meet the current and future needs of all our communities.

In 2022, the EBACC Board, with input from our volunteers and residents, purchased the historical 22 acres formerly known as the Adams County Fairgrounds for the future site of EBACC. We began to research what a Capital Campaign would need to be to create a path to make this vision a reality. We completed a Feasibility Study that concluded there is strong affirmation of the purpose and mission of the East Berlin Area Community Center and the vision to relocate the facilities on the newly purchased property. While there are echoes of sentimental attachment to the current facility, there is widespread constant maintenance and for which EBACC does not have ownership. There is strong affirmation to move forward with a campaign immediately.

In 2023, EBACC retained the architectural firm, Kimmel-Bogrette, for the completion of a Site Feasibility Study and a "Master Concept Plan" to be completed. This "plan" is a fixed cost planning and design tool and was designed to help clients, like EBACC, define their project mission, set project goals, understand constraints, and transform EBACC's vision into reality.

Ballard-King was also hired and worked side-by-side with Kimmel-Brogrette and EBACC to project expenses and the required income of the total operation when the facility is completed. This will provide EBACC with essential information on the additional programs, events and employees needed to be successful. This may affect the building design plan to adhere to a yearly budget that EBACC will be able to remain fiscally responsible.

This Master Plan and Operation Projection is almost complete and we are creating the tools to begin a successful Capital Campaign. Which bring us to the here and now. DAZA Development Group has been hired to lead EBACC through this successful Capital Campaign to fund a new community center that focuses on wellness and fitness for the Adams and York County residents. EBACC and DAZA will work together to build a bond to provide neighboring townships and boroughs services and programs with the goal of pursuing EBACC's Mission of "Enhance the quality of life in our community through recreational activities and classes fostering personal growth".

We will continue to work closely with local and state organizations to ensure that we identify and implement programs that are necessary to enhance our community's well-being and programs to strengthen our resident's day-to-day life for the future.



Cardio Fitness—Jim LeVan, Certified Personal and Group Personal Trainer

Are you an adult who wants to use recreational running for weight loss and more energy; or maybe want to complete your first 5k? If so, then this class is for you! This is a complete program for adults who wish to use a running-based exercise program to increase endurance, strength, and flexibility. The running-based program offers: A training method that uses slow, steady running as the primary exercise with bodyweight strength exercises (push-ups, squats, lunges, and planks) added to build strength and endurance throughout the body. Adults of any ability level are welcome, but participants are expected to run continuously at a jogging pace for 5 minutes.

Class is designed to teach basic principles of strength and conditioning through a routine that targets all muscle groups in a single workout. Class focuses on increasing strength and endurance of upper body, core, and leg muscles and will engage every muscle group in a single, recurring workout. Exercises use moderate weights and frequent repetitions, followed by another exercise targeting a different muscle group. Because the exerciser switches between muscle groups, little rest is needed between exercises.



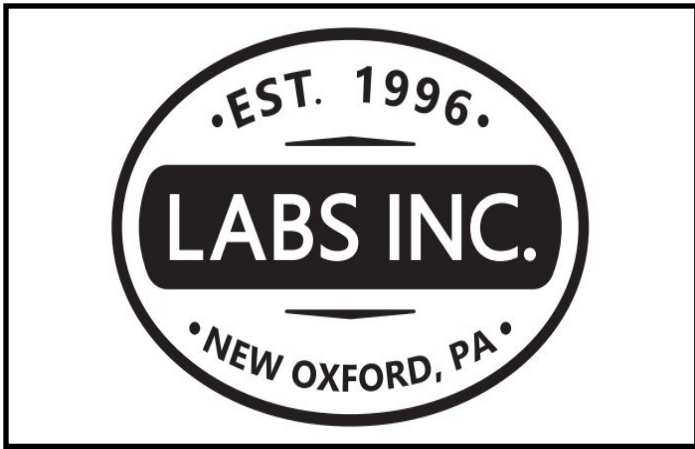
