It's "Show Time" in the historic borough of East Berlin, Adams County, PA. An antique, classic, street rod and modified car and truck show is being added to the Historic East Berlin Fall Festival this year, scheduled for September 14, 8 AM to 2 PM. It will be held in the 18 acre East Berlin Community Park located on North Ave in East Berlin. All years of vehicles are invited and dash plaques will be presented to the first 100 vehicles. Show Registration is the day of the show between 8 AM and 10 AM and there is a \$10 per vehicle registration fee which benefits the East Berlin Community Center. Honored Show Judges from East Berlin Borough, Abbottstown Borough, Reading, Hamilton, Paradise and Washington Townships will judge the vehicles for 12 "I Like That Car" awards. Awards will be presented at 1:30 PM in the park pavilion. In addition to the car and truck show, a "Hubcap Toss Competition" will be held at 11 AM. for the show participants and public attendees. Let's see who has the best tossing arms for the longest distance tossing a hubcap. Trophies will be awarded for the longest toss distance for men, women and children participants. Food and beverage are available in the park the day of the show.

Fire up your special vehicle and come on down to the East Berlin Community Park in historic East Berlin, PA for a fabulous day showing off your pride and joy vehicle during our Historic East Berlin Fall Festival Car Show.
