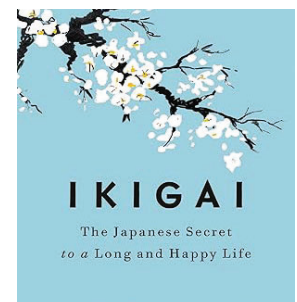

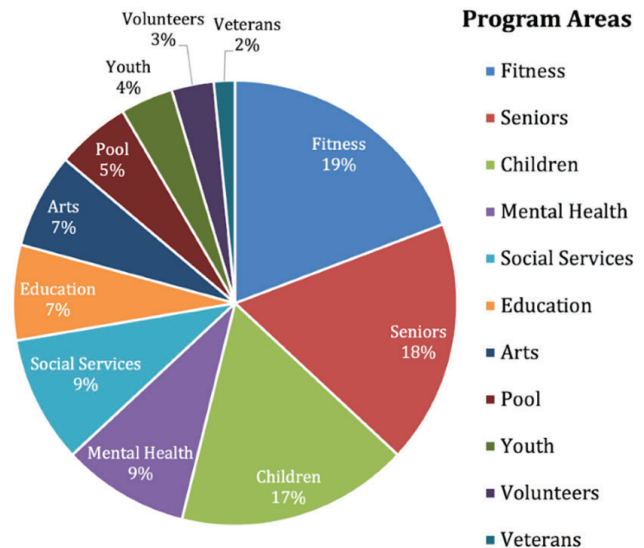

Camp Descriptions

Arts & Crafts Camp

Campers will learn cheer motions, jumps, cheers, chants, and stunting which will help prepare them for school teams. All ability levels are welcome.

Cooking Camp

Campers will be cooking up some delicious eats all week long. Campers learn to measure, count, and estimate in a practical, real-life setting with an edible outcome. The kitchen is the ideal laboratory!

Food Art Camp

Campers will be encouraged to play with their food and make art! It's fun, creative, and delicious! We will use both kitchen skill and creativity in this camp.

Football Camp

We will learn the basics of football-how to throw a football correctly, passes, and formations. We will do drills to encourage mobility and skill. They will play scrimmages. No tackling or pads.

Jewelry Making Camp

Come create some beautiful bead and thread jewelry with us. You will have your choice of beads to make beautiful necklaces, bracelets, and rings. for yourself or make a friendship bracelet to share.

Kinder Camp

Kinder camp is for children 3-5 years old. It's a great introduction to the preschool world. We will make crafts, do weather, calendar, numbers, and letters. Must be potty trained.

Lego Camp

This camp allows children to play and create while exploring engineering, architecture and physics in the wonderful world of Legos.

Outdoor Games Camp

Camp will promote creativity and teamwork using games such as tag, obstacle courses, relay races and more.

Sensory Camp

Campers will explore, engage, and create using their five senses. Each day will provide a variety of sensory experience including physical movement, arts & music.

Science Experiment Camp

Have fun creating chemical reactions with everyday items. Ever wonder what happens when you mix vinegar and baking soda or create a soda geyser?

Soccer Camp

For ages 6-8: Camp provides a fun and structured environment for young players to improve their skills, learn teamwork, and enjoy the sport. There will be a mix of training, games and activities. For ages 9-14: Camp will focus on advanced aspects of soccer, such as stance, positioning, and vision. Campers will learn proper defensive and offensive techniques along with more advanced footwork and overall ball skill.

Sports Sampler Camp

Love sports? This is the camp for you! We will try a different sport each day.

Spy Academy Camp

Each day is packed with action-crawling under "laser beams", racing through obstacle courses, cracking secret codes, and more. Work in teams to solve challenges, rescue captured agents, and upgrade your gadgets to be mission ready.

Super Hero Camp

From designing secret identities and crafting epic capes to conquering obstacle courses and cracking villainous riddles, each action packed day brings a new adventure! Must be potty trained.

Under the Sea Art Camp

In this camp, we'll make 4 art projects inspired by summer ocean themes using watercolor, oil pastels, chalk pastels, and acrylic paint.

Variety Camp

Every day will be different so you won't want to miss a single one. We'll be dancing, dabbling in the arts, going on a treasure hunt, and playing life-sized board games.

Volleyball Camp

In this camp, campers will learn the basics of volleyball like bumping, setting, and spiking.

Child Learning Center

Spaces are limited. All children must be potty trained. These classes are geared toward getting children ready for formal learning. A one time new student registration fee of \$50 is required to reserve a space in the class. Monthly rate is based on a \$15 per instruction day per child. The first person on each waitlist will be contacted when an opening is available.

PreSchool Class

Tuesday & Thursday

9:00am-12:00pm | Starting September 1, 2026 to May 27, 2027

\$120 per month

Class will focus on preschool basics-weather, calendar, introduction to letters and numbers 0-10. They will work on learning to recognize and write their name. There will be weekly themes with fun crafts. They will learn how to listen to someone that isn't Mom or Dad. They will learn to interact with children that are not family members. Must be at least 3 years old by September 1 and must be potty trained.

PreK Class

Monday, Wednesday & Friday

9:00am-12:00pm | Starting August 31, 2026 to May 26, 2027

\$180 per month

Class will focus on preparing children for Kindergarten. They will learn today's preschool basics -- weather, letters, and their sounds, reading readiness skills, sight words, phonemic awareness, kid writing, numbers through at least 20 and simple addition. Developmental play, crafts, and games will be part of their activities. Teacher is familiar with the Kindergarten curriculum to ensure a smooth transition. Must be at least 4 years old and entering Kindergarten in Fall 2027.

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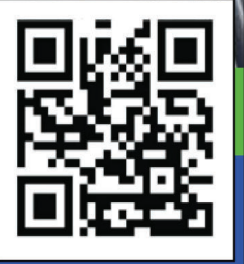
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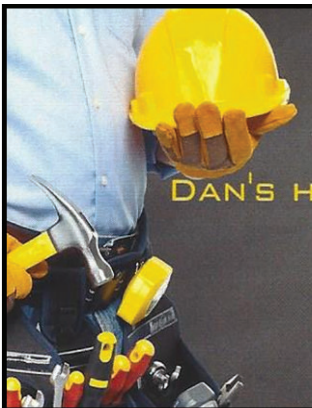
